Gas Station Owner Gives Back to Florence Victims

"When Allenwood Exxon gas station owner Amit Patel saw the devastation left behind from Hurricane Florence, he knew he needed to do something to help. Immediately, he took it upon himself to gather a group of his friends, load up two rented F250's with hitched trailers filled with pallets of water, Gatorade, food, and other needed supplies and drive down to New Bern North Carolina, one of the cities hit hardest by the storm to deliver aid to victims of the storm."
