

## I Passed My A/B Operator Exam...Now What Do I Do Next?

- 1. Congratulations, you passed!
  - a. You received a form stating "Examination Results: PASS"
  - b. Make sure you do not lose this form!
  - c. We suggest you make copies of this form, keep one in your safe, scan and save to a file on your computer.
  - d. Start a file for: NJDEP Operator Training compliance: Class A/B and Class C
  - e. **Note:** On the bottom of the form, it lists your unique <u>registration</u> and <u>validation</u> numbers you will need these numbers later.
- 2. You have to update your UST Registration by completing a <a href="UST Facility Certification">UST Facility Certification</a>
  Questionnaire
  - a. You must complete the form as follows:
    - i. Page 1:
      - 1. Complete: Section A: General Facility Information
      - 2. Make sure you include your UST Facility ID number
      - Complete: 1: Type of Submission Check box C. (Change or Correction)
      - 4. Please also check the box below: Class A or B Operator
      - 5. Complete 2: Total number of regulated USTs
      - 6. Complete 3: Total capacity in gallons
    - ii. Page 2:
      - 1. Make sure you include the UST Facility ID number, which can be found in the upper right corner
      - 2. Complete section 4: Facility Type
      - 3. Complete section 5: Is this a retail service station?
      - 4. Complete section 6: Yes or No
    - iii. Page 3:

- Make sure you include the UST Facility ID number, which can be found in the upper right corner
- 2. Complete section 3: Class A. Operator information
  - a. Include your <u>Registration and Validation</u> number from your "Examination Results: Pass" paperwork
- 3. Complete section4
  - a. You may be able to click the box "Same as Class A Operator"

## iv. Page 6:

- 1. Make sure you include the UST Facility ID number, which can be found in the upper right corner
- 2. Complete Your Signature, Date, Name, Title, UST Facility #

### v. Page 7:

- 1. Make sure you include the UST Facility ID number, which can be found in the upper right corner
- 2. Complete Your Signature, Date, Name, Title, UST Facility #

**Before you prepare to mail the form**, please make copies of the entire form you just completed and keep it in your NJDEP Compliance file.

# If I did not pass the A/B Operator test or will not be certified before the October 13<sup>th</sup>, 2018 compliance date – what happens?

- 1. You will need to <u>hire another Class A/B Operator to act as your site Class A/B Operator</u> in order to be in compliance and follow the steps listed above.
- 2. You can retake the training and test:
  - a. Register for the A/B exam at an ICC test center: <a href="www.iccsafe.org/certification-exam-catalog">www.iccsafe.org/certification-exam-catalog</a>
  - b. Use code "NJ" to search for the correct exam

## What happens if NJDEP comes in for a compliance check and I don't have a Class A/B Operator?

- 1. If NJDEP visits your site for a regulator compliance check, and you do NOT have the Class A/B Operator, you will receive a "Notice of Violation" and you will have 30 days to come in to compliance.
- 2. If after the 30 days you do not have a Class A/B Operator you will then receive a second Notice of Violation and Penalty up to \$7,000 **AND** ...
- 3. You will be subject to a delivery ban. Your UST registration will be deemed invalid without a Class A/B Operator listed on the registration. Deliveries are not permitted at any location without a valid UST registration. Any delivery made to a location without a valid UST registration will generate a \$15,000 penalty to both the delivery company and the UST Operator.
